Notes

Partners discussed three key areas where there is significant issue in Adur and Worthing:

- Loneliness
 - Independent Lives 'Integrated Advocacy' scheme
 - Community (e.g. 'Home Share') & IT (e.g. 'Ralli Round' App) solutions needed
- Excess winter deaths
 - Indicator is unrepresentative of the true picture
 - Pre Winter planning and year round robust prevention more important than cold weather actions
 - Doesn't have to be a cold snap to cost lives
 - Need to address health inequalities: improving housing fundamental; robust flu immunisation programme
 - Families with young children are disproportionately affected
- Readiness for school
 - Almost 50% of children in the area are not 'school ready'. This means socially and / or emotionally; able to: sit still, share, dress themselves, express their needs
 - Home Start's Big Hopes Big Future volunteer project to support 21/2 to 4 year olds
 - Five to Thrive event - 03.12.15 Exploring the five things children need to thrive
- Local Vision Pilot - deferred to a future meeting
